

The Competition College of the BCA authorises the acquisition of Telelinq by Telenet

The Competition College of the Belgian Competition Authority (BCA) has authorised on 22 May 2018 the acquisition of Telelinq NV by Telenet Group BVBA.

Telelinq NV, which operates on the market under the name Nextel, offers global network and telecommunication solutions mainly to SMEs, large companies, care facilities, non-profit organisations and administrations in Belgium ("integrator" services).

The College has decided, following the proposal of the competition prosecutor, that the concentration does not cause a significant restriction of competition on the concerned market.
