

**The Belgian Competition Authority approves the acquisition of Nastor NV by Group Nastor BVBA**

The Investigation and Prosecution Service of the Belgian Competition Authority (BCA) has approved on 21 December 2018 the acquisition of Nastor NV and (indirectly) Aldron NV by Group Nastor BVBA.

The merger was notified on 10 December 2018. The application of the simplified procedure was requested.

Group Nastor BVBA is controlled by Wiho GCV which is through its majority participation indirectly active in the sector for the placement of workers through the service voucher system.

Nastor NV is through its subsidiary Aldron NV also active in the sector for the placement of workers through the service voucher system.

In its decision of 21 December 2018, the BCA finds that the conditions for the application of the simplified procedure are met and that the notified merger does not raise any objection.
