

Transposition of the ECN+ Directive

The Act of 28 February 2022 transposing Directive (EU) 2019/1 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2018 to empower the competition authorities of the Member States to be more effective enforcers and to ensure the proper functioning of the internal market, has been published in the Belgian Official Gazette on 7 March 2022.

This Act will enter into force on 17 March 2022.
