The Belgian Competition Authority approves the acquisition of Teugels Invest BV, Teugels BV, Vleesgroothandel Rima NV and Rikstrans BV by Hempo BV

On 13 December 2022, the Belgian Competition Authority (BCA) approved the acquisition of Teugels BV (Teugels), Teugels Invest SRL (Teugels Invest), Vleesgroothandel Rima NV (Rima) and Rikstrans BV (Rikstrans) by Hempo BV (Hempo).

The concentration was notified on 30 November 2022 and the application of the simplified procedure was requested.

Hempo is a Belgian holding under the control of Frelotte BV and Hemcor BV, that in turn also control Hemelaer NV and CDM NV. Hemelaer NV and CDM NV are active in Belgium in the purchase of live cattle and calves for the slaughter (in contract slaughter) and in the sale of fresh beef, veal, game and lamb meat and the sale of citrus and lime juices, respectively.

Teugels is a Belgian company active in the purchase of live cattle and pigs for the slaughter (in contract slaughter) and in the sale of fresh beef, veal, pork and horse meat.

Teugels Invest is a real estate company.

Rima is a Belgian company mainly active in Belgium in the purchase of live cattle and pigs for the slaughter (in contract slaughter). In addition, Rima is active in the sale of fresh beef, veal, pork meat and abattoir byproducts.

Rikstrans is a Belgian transport company which transports its own meat.
