### The Belgian Competition Authority approves the acquisition of TDP by GIMV

On 13 December 2024, the Belgian Competition Authority (“BCA”) approved the acquisition of TDP by GIMV.

The concentration was notified on 4 December 2024 and the application of the simplified procedure was requested.

GIMV is an investment company focusing on direct investments in small to medium-sized companies headquartered in Belgium, France, Germany, the Netherlands and Switzerland. GIMV is controlled by WorxInvest.

TDP is a company active in developing, investing in and managing a wide range of infrastructure and selective real estate.

The BCA's investigation found that the notified concentration does not give rise to any overlaps between the undertakings concerned.

In its decision of 13 December 2024, the BCA found that the conditions for the application of the simplified procedure were met and that the notified concentration did not raise objections.
