

## **The Belgian Competition Authority approves the acquisition of A.M. Group by Trixxo Jobs**

On 17 December 2024, the Belgian Competition Authority (“BCA”) approved the acquisition of A.M. Group by Trixxo Jobs.

The concentration was notified on 11 December 2024 and the application of the simplified procedure was requested.

Trixxo Jobs is part of the Trixxo Group, a services group which has become specialised in housekeeping services and temporary employment (with permanent employment possibilities) in Belgium (primarily in Flanders) and the Netherlands.

A.M. Group is a services group active in HR-services in Belgium (primarily in Flanders). A.M. Group is active in different sectors with varying packages, including temporary employment, *payroll* and *projectsourcing* services, both through brick and mortar agencies and online platforms.

In its decision of 17 December 2024, the BCA found that the conditions for the application of the simplified procedure were met and that the notified concentration did not raise objections.
